Who we are

MINEART is a 2 year Erasmus+ Program to promote innovative methods of participatory and intercultural communication in school education. The project intends to provide various approaches and digital tools to help students comprehend the essence of European citizenship through art.

The context

In Europe, art education is considered essential for a well-rounded education, focusing on creativity, critical thinking, and cultural awareness through visual arts, music, theater, and dance.

Interactive Map

The project will create a dedicated portal hosted on the MINEART website that will include all educational materials and will also provide an interactive map where students can locate famous art in the European map.

Minecraft Game

The second result of the project aims at creating an interactive Minecraft game that offers an educational and enjoyable gamified environment for primary education students. Students will have the opportunity of exploring famous artworks in the world of Minecraft.

Target Group

The main focus of this initiative is on children of primary education 6-12 in primary school, with particular attention given to those who have fewer opportunities, including girls and students from remote rural areas such as islands.
